VICTORS Study

Visual Structure and Function in Contact Sport Athletes

WHO?

We are recruiting 150 subjects for two study groups:

1. Contact sport athletes (Football, Boxing, Hockey, Soccer and Rugby)
Active or retired professional contact sport athletes
2. Non-contact sport athletes
Athletes in non-contact sports or subjects not engaged in sports

WHAT?

This is a multi-centered, national study. The goal of this study is to determine if professional contact sports athletes have a greater amount of thinning in the retina compared to people who have not participated in contact sports and whether there is a correlation with visual function.

HOW?

Vision testing and non-invasive retinal picture scans

HOW LONG?

Approximately 30 minutes/session

This is intended to be a long term study lasting approximately 5 years, with annual follow-up visits.
