The Concussion Legacy Project is led by Dr. Gabriele De Luca, Professor of Clinical Neurology and Experimental Neuropathology in the Nuffield Department of Clinical Neurosciences, University of Oxford and Director of Clinical Neurosciences Undergraduate Education at Oxford Medical School.

The process:

- Sign up to our clinical registers <u>here</u>.
- When your loved one passes away, contact our brain donation team on 07534 029 223.
- One of our Neuropathologists at the Oxford Brain Bank will examine the brain and undertake the standardised range of tests for CTE and other conditions.
- The next of kin will be contacted post examination for a consultation meeting whereby the findings will be explained.
- Throughout this process, and beyond, you will have access to the Concussion Legacy Family community and to support from the CLF team.

I don't know how we would have ever come to terms with what we had been through, had we not received answers through brain donation. It meant the world to us to hear there was a reason for our suffering and that we could connect with other families who had shared similar experiences.
